The Chief Superintendent, Departmental Tests Nov-2015 Session, Trinity Junior College Kamal Complex opp II Town Police Station, Karimnagar in special Report brought to the notice of the Commission, that during the conduct of Departmental Tests i.e., P.C-52 Registration Dept. Test Written Examination (objective type) held on 26/05/2016 as per the report received from the Chief Superintendent the candidate Smt. Chaduvu Jyothi bearing Register No. 22501741 indulged in Malpractice case as she was using Mobile Phone during the examination and sent the question paper through Whatsapp and obtained the answers. The moment her mobile was seized the fact that she used Whatsapp to indulge in cheating was established, when the mobile was opened later she pleaded with the C.S & took back the Mobile on the plea to call her parents, but in fact threw the mobile on the ground and stamped it several times to break it to destroy the evidence.

She brought un due influence on the C.S & deputed officials of TSPSC not to book a malpractice case against her. And during the return journey with the examination material, the TSPSC officials were threatened by her henchmen following them on motor bike of dire consequences if a case is booked against her, with the result the TSPSC officials had to return to Hyderabad by hiring a taxi. The offences committed by her are grave in nature in unbecoming of a Govt. Servant.
