In the ref 1st cited Sri. K.Naresh Kumar, was appointed as Junior Assistant on compassionate grounds in the O/o TSPSC. As per the Rules stated in G.O. 2nd cited, his appointment was made purely on temporary basis on a condition that he is liable for termination at any time without prior notice and without assigning any reasons. Accordingly, he has reported to duty on 28/04/2017.

Sri. K.Naresh Kumar remained absent from duties w.e.f. 28/06/2017 to till date without any leave or intimation to the office. Accordingly a memo was already served to the individual vide ref. 3rd cited, directing him to report to duty. But there is no response from the individual. Therefore, the individual was issued a show-cause notice in person, vide ref 4th cited, as to why he should not be discharged from his duties for his willful and unauthorized absence from duties and was also directed to submit his statement of defense in writing, otherwise action deemed fit would be initiated as per rules.

Though the individual was given (2) opportunities, there is no intimation or information from the individual, which means that he has remained absent from the office willfully. It is therefore construed that the individual has no interest to continue in the job.

Vide ref 5th cited, a Public Notice has also been issued stating that as per rules, the individual is deemed to have been removed from service and he is informed accordingly. Even after the publication of this notice, there is no response and information from the individual.

On the basis of above circumstances and as per rule and orders issued in references 6th & 7th cited, in all cases of unauthorized absence to duty for a continuous period exceeding 'one year', the penalty of removal from service shall be imposed on the Government employee, after duly following the procedure laid down in the APCS(CCA) Rules, 1991, vide ref 8th cited.

Therefore in view of the said facts and rule position stated above, the individual Sri. K.Naresh Kumar is removed from the post of Junior Assistant in the Commission's Office.
